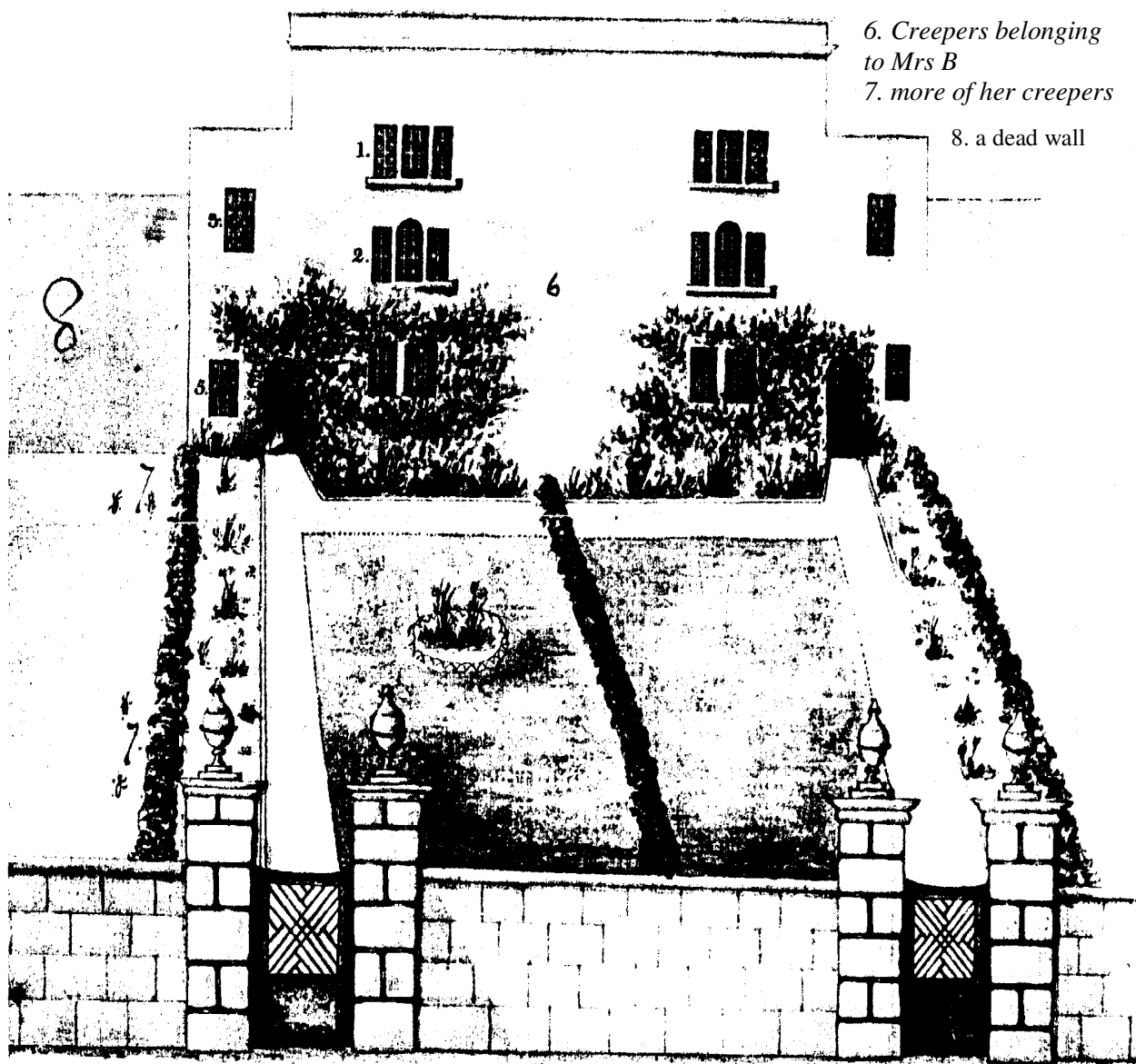


**DEVONSHIRE BUILDINGS** is situate on a beautiful eminence and consists of ten of these Double Cottages extending on a line from East to West. At the end of this Row runs the Grand Western entrance into Bath in the direction from North to South, by which these Cottages have the entertainment, without the inconvenience, of the dust of the great Public Road –

" 2 Drawing Room at the back of which M<sup>r</sup> Brook's Dressing Room in which Moore sleeps.

" 3 Library at the back of which is the Breakfast Room

" 4 Dining Parlour at the back of which is the Hall Butlers Pantry and a small Vestibule

" 5 Garden Room in which stands the Ship,  
and two female servants sleep in this room and at the back of it is the kitchen scullery etc

Note. The Wash House and other Offices, stand in the Coach Yard
